$\square \quad$ A player's four best scores will count towards their end of season total which shall decide the 2009 English Partnerships Golf Society Championship.
$\square \quad$ In the event of a tie for first place at the end of the season the overall winner will be determined on the basis of, firstly, the aggregate of the five best scores and, if still tied, on the aggregate of all six scores; if either one or more of the tied players attends only four events the winner will be the player with the lowest aggregate of placings over their best four events (e.g. $1 \mathrm{st} / 2 \mathrm{nd} / 2 \mathrm{nd} / 4 \mathrm{th}=9$ beats $1 \mathrm{st} / 3 \mathrm{rd} / 4 \mathrm{th} / 5 \mathrm{th}=13$ ).
$\square \quad$ A player's handicap will be reduced as follows: a) handicaps $0-9$, one stroke reduction if highest scorer at any two of the six events; b) handicaps $10-18$, one stroke reduction if highest scorer at any one of the six events; and c) handicaps 19-28, at least one stroke reduction for every score of 30 or more points at any of the six events plus an additional stroke reduction if highest scorer at any one of the six events.
$\square \quad$ A player's handicap will be increased by one stroke should that player score at least five points less than the average score for the full round at any Society event (increase to apply as from the next event); the average score will be calculated by dividing the aggregate points score for the day by the number of members competing at that event (i.e. scores by guests will be excluded from this calculation).
$\square \quad$ Should a Society member come second to a guest in any event both member and guest will count as 'highest scorer' for handicap reduction purposes.
$\square \quad$ In addition to the specific amendments set out in the preceding paragraphs, the handicap sub committee will hold an end of season review to consider whether players' Society handicaps are in need of any additional downward or upward revision (subject to the maximum allowable handicap of 28).
